On the 21st of August 2018 Microsoft was certified and listed on the Certified Cloud Services List at the PROTECTED classification level for the following service:

- Azure

The Microsoft certification letter expired on the 1st of September 2019. Due to delays within the ACSC certification program, Microsoft has not been assessed for recertification.

However, the ACSC is satisfied that Microsoft remains compliant with the applicable ISM controls to process, store, and transmit Australian Government information up to, and including, PROTECTED.

This letter is to confirm the above Microsoft services continue to be certified at the PROTECTED classification level in accordance with the conditions of the certification letter. This certification extension is valid till the 30/09/2020.

In association with the terms of the certification process, Microsoft must continue to make the associated ACSC certification report and any supporting documents available to Australian Government agencies intending to utilise these cloud services. This is so they are aware and accept any identified residual risks and shared security responsibilities.
